

Codes of Ethics and Practice

1	Obtain informed consent from clients entering a counseling relationship.
2	Respect a client's confidentiality and
-	privacy.
3	Explain to clients what the counseling relationship entails (fees, group work, and termination).
	Be cognizant of client's culture, values, and
4	beliefs.
5	Uphold full integrity and respect related to professional competencies.

Clearly, the Code of Ethics and Practice applies to Counsellors' work-related activities. With

high standards of ethical conduct, counsellors and psychotherapists are supported to protect clients from harm; thereby optimising client recovery and healing.
